Improving Worship?

Does any and all worship please God? (John 4:24) Apparently the position and location of my heart matters... why? (Mark 7:6-7) Apparently how I live with my wife affects my prayer offerings... why? (1 Peter 3:7) Apparently God hated Israel's worship at this point in time, why? (Amos 5:21-24) Apparently God values obedience over sacrifices... why? (1 Samuel 15:22-23)

The primary object of our worship is God, right? The primary direction of our praise is heavenward, correct? If we're trying to please God in our worship shouldn't we offer him the very best of our hearts and obedience?

Someone can speak from the heart extemporaneously, in the moment. Can someone also speak from the heart with thoughtful preparation? Someone can pray and utter groaning that only the Spirit can translate (Romans 8:26-27). Can someone also prepare a thoughtful written prayer to read in public? Someone can check their pockets for loose change and put it in the collection plate. Can someone also write four or five checks at the beginning of the month to deliver each week? Someone can flip to any song in the book and sing it with all heart. Can someone also plan a worship service on a theme, melding lesson, prayer, scripture, and song together, blended in beautiful musical and spiritual harmony!

When we sing, who is the primary audience, or receiver? Who are the secondary and tertiary parties receiving benefits? So how do we estimate the effectiveness of our worship? Whose criteria do we use? (Colossians 3:17, 23; Ecclesiastes 9:10) Surely it's not mine! Certainly it's not yours!

The improvements we can make are most likely internal over external. They relate to how I can help someone else, and then receive residual benefit. Worshipping together is very much about building up (1 Corinthians 14:4, 12, 26; Ephesians 4:12, 16, 29). So please go to bed with worship in mind, rise up and prepare. Prepare your mind for worship all week. The regular spiritual rhythm God set up for us is a precious gift. We aim for our special gathering as the culmination of hopes and intentions. We use that same worship assembly as the springboard launching us into a span of practical service. There may be many dimensions for worship improvement we can find if we seek them out. Most of them will be centered on what is most pleasing to God and what comes from a sincere heart, both spirit and truth. May God bless you all!
