Perfectly Complete

He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high... Hebrews 1:3

I have made a startling and profound discovery: Imperfection and incompleteness are realities of human existence. Case in point: I laboriously cleaned a window last week, carefully checking and rechecking to make sure no dirt or streaks were left, only to find the next day that several streaks and spots remained. Further, even if the window had been perfectly clean, it will need to be cleaned again at some point in the future.

In fact, I've never been completely satisfied with the "finished product" in any of my own "creative" efforts. And almost everything that needs to be done today will also need to be done again tomorrow, or next week, or next year. With these realities in mind, some would, and in fact do, become despondent at the seeming hopelessness of human existence. If I can't work myself into a state of perfection, what hope is there for my salvation?

Encouragement on this subject is found in the wonderful picture of Jesus presented by the Hebrews writer. Jesus, he says to us, is better than angels and better than Moses. He is better, in fact, than any other person or agency that might be perceived to draw man and God together. This unidentified author goes even so far as to suggest that Jesus is as "perfect" and "complete" as God himself, because he is, after all, the Son of God who perfectly "mirrors" God in every respect (because he is God!!).

No where is the importance of this completely perfect nature of Jesus better presented that in the statement of Hebrews 1:3. "After making purification for sins," our writer tells us, Jesus "sat down" at God's right hand. He finished the job – completely. He did so to the satisfaction of the perfectionist Creator of the universe, who welcomed Jesus to his throne at the task's completion. Game over, never to be played again. Job complete, tools never again to be taken in hand. Purification provided, blood spilled, death defeated, sin atoned, enemies reconciled.

As you go through today's endless list of often- repeated, never-completed, imperfectlypresented tasks in your life, give thanks for the perfect and complete salvation provided by Jesus. And while you're at it, mark that chore off of your list – it never belonged there in the first place.
