## **Spiritual Visibility**

The Bible says, "You are the Light of the world." and, "...let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven." (Matthew 5:14, 16). One of the most important things light can do is increase visibility. When driving at night we're supposed to make sure headlights are working so we can navigate effectively and so other drivers can avoid collisions. One of the many reasons the city of Jerusalem was built on a hill was for weary travelers to be able to find it.

We need to think about our Christian communities. Are they visible to weary, lost, travelers of this life-draining world? Jesus is the Light of the World! (John 8:12) His mission was to shine light into the darkness, to increase spiritual visibility for all (John 1:5, 9-13). Jesus commissioned His followers to mimic Him, to be light bearers. Paul told us what method to use (Ephesians 5:8-14). Our actions can either blur the visibility of sin or expose it, so people can clearly see the difference. Living in the light does not invoke judgement on those living in darkness; God is judge. However, light-filled lifestyles are clearly visible to all! We're not forcing the issue when we choose to do what is right! We simply ignite the beacon for those seeking, and in need.

Jesus started with the grand scale of a city, then He tells us we need light to fill our own homes as well **(Matthew 5:15)**. What good is it for me to shine spotlights out into the world in an attempt to save strangers when there isn't enough light in my home for my own family to see Jesus clearly? My friends, home should be my first ministry.

How do we accomplish this light shining task? Through good deeds, beautiful works, doing the kinds of things you *can* do in the light! Our motivation is also important. We don't have to judge someone else's choices to fulfill the mission, and we also don't have to draw attention to ourselves (Matthew 6:1). If it is a Christlike action, He will receive the glory and credit. We reflect His light; we don't generate it on our own. It's time to shine the high beams on the highway of life so folks can see the danger ahead. Will you help me increase spiritual visibility in our world today?
