The Happiness Formula

In 1776, a special document, prepared and signed by 56 revolutionaries, spearheaded tremendous change and laid a strong foundation for our country, the United States of America. This Declaration of Independence contains an oft quoted maxim in the second sentence: "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness." The danger of these words is that when we take them for granted we assume that this sense of happiness is a God-given right, an American's destiny. The reality is that we're not nearly as happy as we want or even claim to be. Why is that?

Many things can be sold on the strength of the promise of happiness, and we have typically been gullible enough to buy them, the toothpaste, the gadget, the car and more. However, even in our state of affluence, technology, and convenience happiness is even more elusive! The suicide rate is horrendous. The number of people receiving professional treatment for depression is in the millions. The search for virtual pleasure online could be the most addictive diversion of our generation. We humans still seek and expect happiness, but we have no idea where to find it (Ecclesiastes 1:14). We cannot create or find happiness on our own; it is absolutely a gift from God!

True happiness is found in being a child of God! Sadly, we often find ourselves in the other category (John 8:44). The good news (Gospel) is, we can be born again (John 3:3-5). When we experience this new birth we can live to honor our new Father! Happiness is not only to know I'm God's child, but also to know that He loves me. It's to know I can call on Him at any moment, to know He's eager to listen and bless His children. It makes us deeply happy to know He loves us more than any earthly father possibly could!

The saddest part about our lack of happiness is that it's unnecessary! We have the luxury and daily opportunity to choose life (Deuteronomy 30:19-20). God has placed this power within every single human being. We can choose to pursue a happiness not based on external circumstance but on internal, eternal joy in Christ! Jesus explains this happy state in detail in what we tend to call the Beatitudes (Matthew 5:1-12). A study of these unique verses would be most beneficial to anyone who desires the happiness that only God can provide. Will you pursue it with your self-evident equality, life, and freedom?
