Eager Expectation

Luke 2:22-38

There are few things more difficult in this life than waiting for the Lord. It sounds appealing to be one of the people of Israel that Moses led out of 400 years of Egyptian slavery, surrounded by signs and wonders. But who would really want to be part of the generations of slaves between the years, say, 200-250? It would mean that neither you nor your great grandparents had ever known freedom, nor would you or your great grandchildren. Yet it was crucial that the chain of faith remain unbroken and that Israel keep telling and retelling the stories of God's faithfulness and hoping in the Lord, who would not leave them there forever.

Yet somehow, long awaited expectations are doubly as sweet when they are fulfilled. If you reared your children to be Christians, the day couldn't get here soon enough for them to finally decide to name Jesus as Lord in baptism. If it hasn't happened for you yet, it is undoubtedly part of your daily prayers and your heart's most eager yearnings.

Luke's Gospel records the stories of two very sweet older people that Mary and Joseph encounter when they bring Jesus to the Temple for his dedication. Simeon has been promised by the Holy Spirit that he would not die before he sees the Messiah. Anna is married for just seven years and then widowed until the age of eighty-six. One can only imagine how many days, months, and years they have prayed, wondering when God was going to give them a new blessing. It's easy to pray when we see our prayers being answered but much harder to keep praying when we cannot know what God is doing.

Being people of hope means that we continue on steadfastly with eager expectation that God will make a way where there is no other way. Simeon never quit wait- ing for and expecting the hope of Israel to come. And what would he tell you on that day, after he holds the Lord of all creation in his own hands? "Don't give up, and don't quit hoping. It's worth it."
